



Incubator Room Visitation Policy

- Parents are welcome 24 hours a day.
- Parents may bring 2 visitors during feeding times.
- Visitors are not permitted after 22:00h.
- Arrangements can be made with the nurse for more visitors on the day of the birth.
- Only parents may hold and care for their child when he/she is in the incubator. Arrangements can also be made with the nurse for your visitors to hold your child when the child is not in the incubator.
- Parents are kindly requested to comply with the hygiene guidelines of the department and provide appropriate instructions about this to accompanying visitors.
- Brothers and sisters may come inside, provided they are not sick and have already had chickenpox.
- Telephone calls are not permitted in the department. However, you may use your telephone to take pictures and/or send messages.
- During skin-to-skin contact, use of a mobile telephone is not recommended.
- Accompanying visitors during skin-to-skin contact are not recommended. You can enjoy your baby with plenty of peace and quiet.
- With regard to privacy, contact with babies other than your own is not permitted.
- Only the parents may receive information about the health of their baby.
- Jewellery and jackets may not be worn for reasons of hygiene and due to the chance of infection.
- Upon entering, wash and sterilise your hands with alcohol.
