



Registration of your child

Congratulations on the birth of your child.

You have to arrange a number of practical matters after birth. One of them is 'registering your child'.

You must register your child within three days of the birth.

The registration of the birth is done by the father or by someone who was present at the birth.

What do you need to take along?

For registration you will need the following items:

- A valid ID (passport or European identity card) for both parents;
- Marriage certificate (if parents are married);
- Acknowledgement papers (if you are not married, but you acknowledge the baby).

The declarant can report to the central information desk in the town hall.

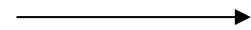
